CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

April 2019

Dear Resident,

As part of the City of Ottawa's annual infrastructure maintenance cycle, road resurfacing will occur to improve roadways and the citywide transportation network. The road resurfacing program will begin in April and will continue until October 2019. At some time during the construction season, a roadway will be resurfaced in your neighbourhood.

- Who:** The Contractor, **Aecon Construction Ontario East Limited**, will be performing the construction work for the City of Ottawa.
- Why:** The City of Ottawa will be resurfacing roads as preventative maintenance aimed at extending the City's roadway network lifecycle.
- What:** Work will involve milling of the existing surface, adjustment of manhole and catch basin grates, concrete repairs, and roadway resurfacing.
- When:** This work is **tentatively planned to start in April, weather permitting**. Completion is anticipated by October 2019.
- Where:** Work will occur along **St. Joseph Boulevard**.

The following roadways **will be resurfaced during the days and evenings or nights**, and will involve minor lane interruptions:

- St. Joseph Boulevard from the OR174 IC109 Ramp 54 (Montreal Road Eastbound Off Ramp) to Youville Drive
- St. Joseph Boulevard, 100 metres East of Jeanne d'Arc Boulevard South to Prestone Drive

Accessibility

Accessibility is an important consideration for the City of Ottawa. The City makes every effort to provide access through and around construction sites. If you require special accommodation, please contact the City's Project Manager or the Contractor's Representative.

Parking

The Contractor is obligated to provide 24 hour notification of temporary loss of access / egress. In the event that access to your driveway is restricted due to construction activities, a Temporary On-Street Parking Permit (orange form) will be distributed to permit on-street parking within two blocks of your residence.
